The Technical Standards online the competition at the national level and are used to prepare the state-level competition. This document outlines any differences between the state and national contest, as it relates to those standards.

CONTEST OVERVIEW

Contestants will prepare the items listed below in advance of the conference, and bring them to display onsite. The printed designs must adhere to an overall theme of the student's choice. They will participate in an interview about their items, and the quality of production will be judged. Displays must include the required items and may include a tri-fold display illustrating the processes used or displaying the overall theme of the products.

GENERAL DISPLAY INFORMATION

Displays will be set up on April 11 beginning at 8 AM. Displays will remain set until at least 2 PM on April 12, or until judging is complete, and must be removed no later than 4 PM on April 12. Displays that are not removed by the deadline will be disposed of by SkillsUSA Florida staff. Each contestant is provided with no less than ½ of an 8' table to display their work.

SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS

SUPPLIED BY THE CONTESTANT:

- One-page, typewritten resume
- Items for judging and display at the competition:
 - One printed coffee mug
 - One printed plaque
 - One printed t-shirt
 - Two other printed items of the student's choice
- The printed designs should adhere to an overall theme of the student's choice
- All items must be created by the student, without assistance or interference from anyone else.
