STATE CONTEST OUTLINE

The following outline should be used as a guide. Contestants will be provided with a detailed schedule during contest orientation.

- 8:15 AM – Sculptured Nail Application – 60 minutes
- 9:30 AM – Tip Application with UV/LED Gel Overlay – 60 minutes
- 10:45 AM – Pedicure Procedure (one foot) – 30 minutes
- 11:30 AM – Lunch
- 12 PM – Polish Application and Nail Art – 90 minutes
- 1:45 PM – Oral Assessment – 3-4 minutes
- 2:30 PM – Parade and Debrief
- Safety and Professionalism – judged continuously during the contest
- Technical Assessment – online in advance of the contest
- Professional Development Assessment – online in advance of the contest

SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS

Provided by the Contest Committee:

- Technical guidelines for the specific applications required to be performed
- One electrical outlet per competitor

Provided by the Contestant:

- Safety glasses for competitor and model
- White terry towels – no holes or stains, at least 6.
- Disposable towels for the table
- Water – 1 gallon in a sealable container
- Plastic bags for disposal and refuse
- All items necessary to complete a basic pedicure – **STATE ONLY**
 - NOTE: Implements should be brought to the competition ready to use (i.e., cleaned and disinfected, or new). Lotion, masks, scrubs, and/or callus removers must be from the same professional manufacturer. Products should include antibacterial foot soak, skin/callus softener, exfoliating scrub, and massage oil/lotion.
- Water basin or portable foot spa – **STATE ONLY**
- Any items necessary for a mock client consultation on natural nail care services
- All items necessary to complete five nails with a tip and light-cured enhancement overlay. Can be a hard gel or a hybrid gel/acrylic product.
 - NOTE: Gel polish, temporary, or no-light gels may not be used.
- Dark red crème lacquer/polish
- All items allowed to complete the flat nail art application. Medium choices: acrylic paints, polishes/lacquers, colored powders (acrylic and dip), gel polish, rhinestones sizes 20ss and under, glitters and dusts, and adhesives, i.e., gel top coats/glue
 - NOTE: No pre-prepared items can be used; items are limited to those intended for use on nails. A topcoat may be used as a sealer.
- A written description of the nail art theme. Themes are to be typewritten, should include pictures and be contained within a plastic sleeve.
 - NOTE: Due at contest orientation.
- Portable kit organizer (to transport all items necessary for the competition)
- Manicure table lamp and extension cord (optional)
- A USB Drive with a digital photo of nail art to be created during contest. Photo may include props.
- One page typewritten resume
- **All items necessary to complete five sculptured acrylic nails. Note: Dappen dishes must have covers; monomer, polymer and primer must be from the same manufacturer; two or more of the four basic acrylic colors (pink, white, clear or natural) must be used to complete two-tone/French manicure sculpted nails.**

NOTE: Electric drills/files are not allowed.
