


The SkillsUSA Framework is the foundation of all our programs. It's made up of three components: Personal, Workplace and Technical Skills grounded in academics.

# **SLSC 2023 BY THE NUMBERS**

# Total attendance of 1,911 includes:

**1,178 student competitors** in 99 hands-on or leadership contests Over **100 students** served as voting delegates, volunteers or observers

Attendance is **57% male**




