CONTESTS WITH PRE-CONFERENCE UPLOAD REQUIREMENTS

CONTESTS REQUIRING PRE-CONFERENCE UPLOAD:

• Digital Cinema – DUE APRIL 5, 2024, by 5 PM ET

Teams were emailed the prompt on April 1, 2024, at 12 PM ET, and instructors were emailed the prompt on April 2 at 12 PM. Final videos are due according to the contest prompt.

• Entrepreneurship – DUE APRIL 8, 2024, by 5 PM ET

An electronic copy of the team's business case must be uploaded as one PDF file. A hard copy of the business case must be brought to the competition, as outlined in the contest Technical Standards.

• Graphic Imaging Sublimation – DUE APRIL 10, 2024 by 5 PM ET

Contestants will create artwork according to the prompt emailed to instructors and contestants on April 2, 2024. Two .psd files and one .pdf file must be uploaded.

• Mobile Robotics – DUE APRIL 8, 2024, by 5 PM ET

A scanned PDF copy of the engineering notebook must be uploaded by the deadline. The notebook will be reviewed by judges in advance so they can be familiar with projects prior to the contest. Teams may continue to update notebooks as they develop their robots in the final days leading up to the competition. The full bound notebook must be brought to the competition in person.

• Robotics Urban Search and Rescue – DUE APRIL 8, 2024, by 5 PM ET

A scanned PDF copy of the engineering notebook must be uploaded by the deadline. The notebook will be reviewed by judges in advance so they can be familiar with projects prior to the contest. Teams may continue to update notebooks as they develop their robots in the final days leading up to the competition. The full notebook must be brought to the competition in person.

• Welding Sculpture – DUE APRIL 5, 2024, by 5 PM ET

Digital copy of binder contents must be uploaded as one PDF file. A hard copy of the binder must be brought to the competition, along with the digital files saved to a USB flash drive, as outlined in the contest Technical Standards.
